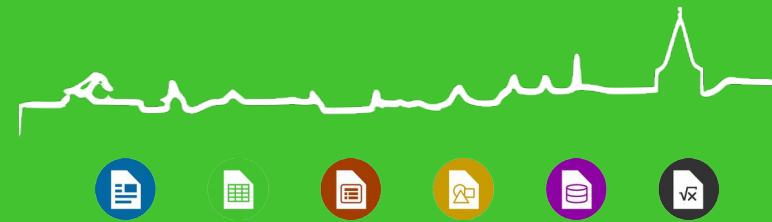

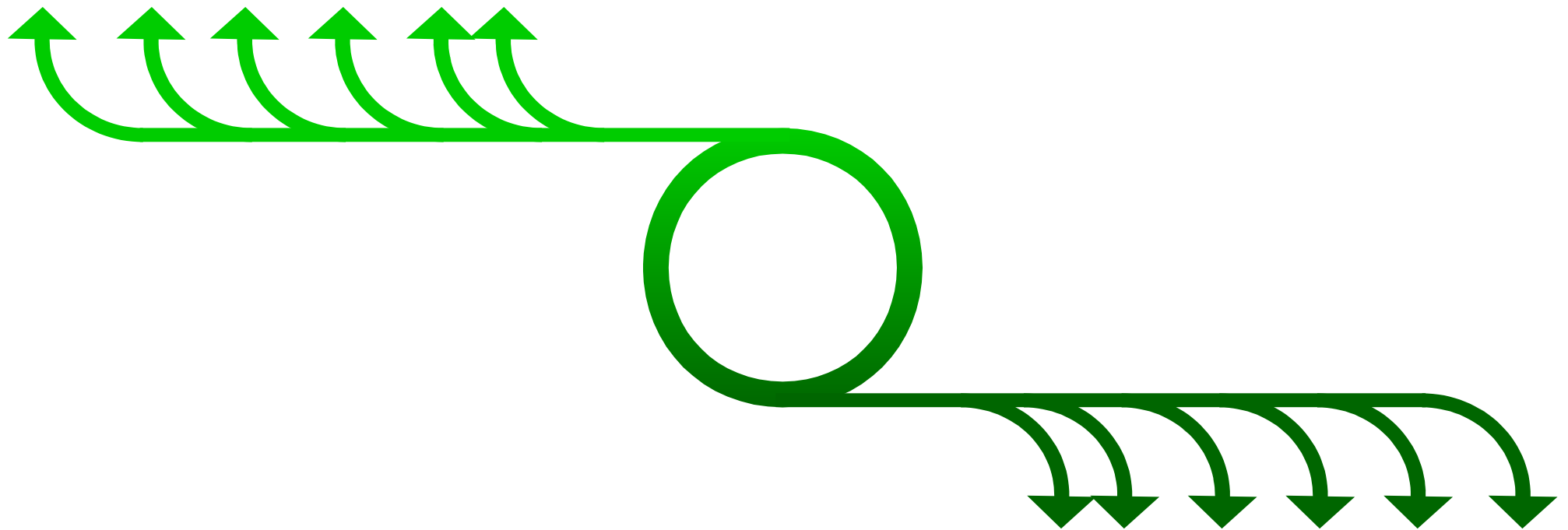

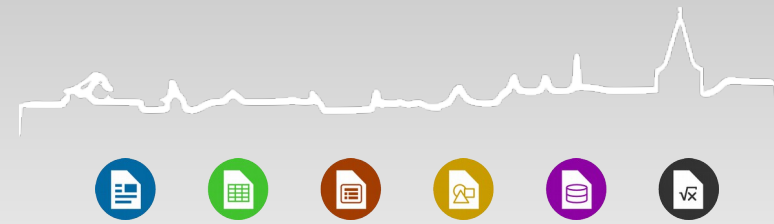


LibreOffice Release Cycle (one year)

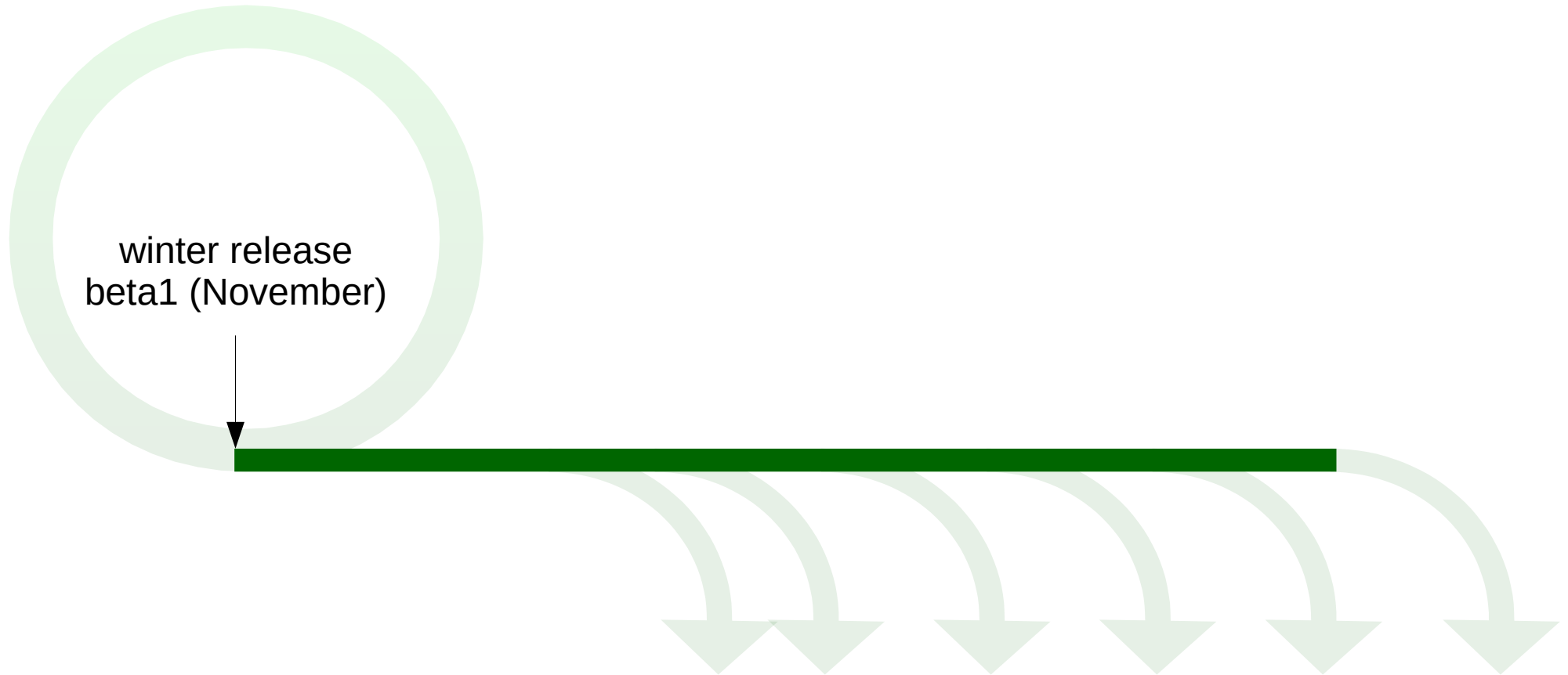


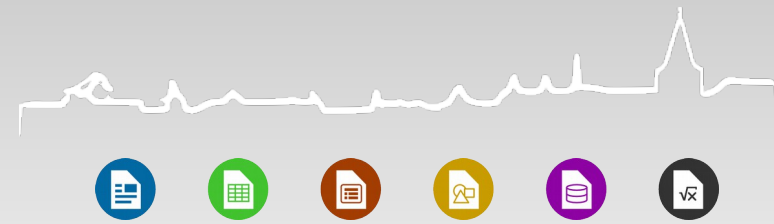
LibreOffice Master Branch (one year)



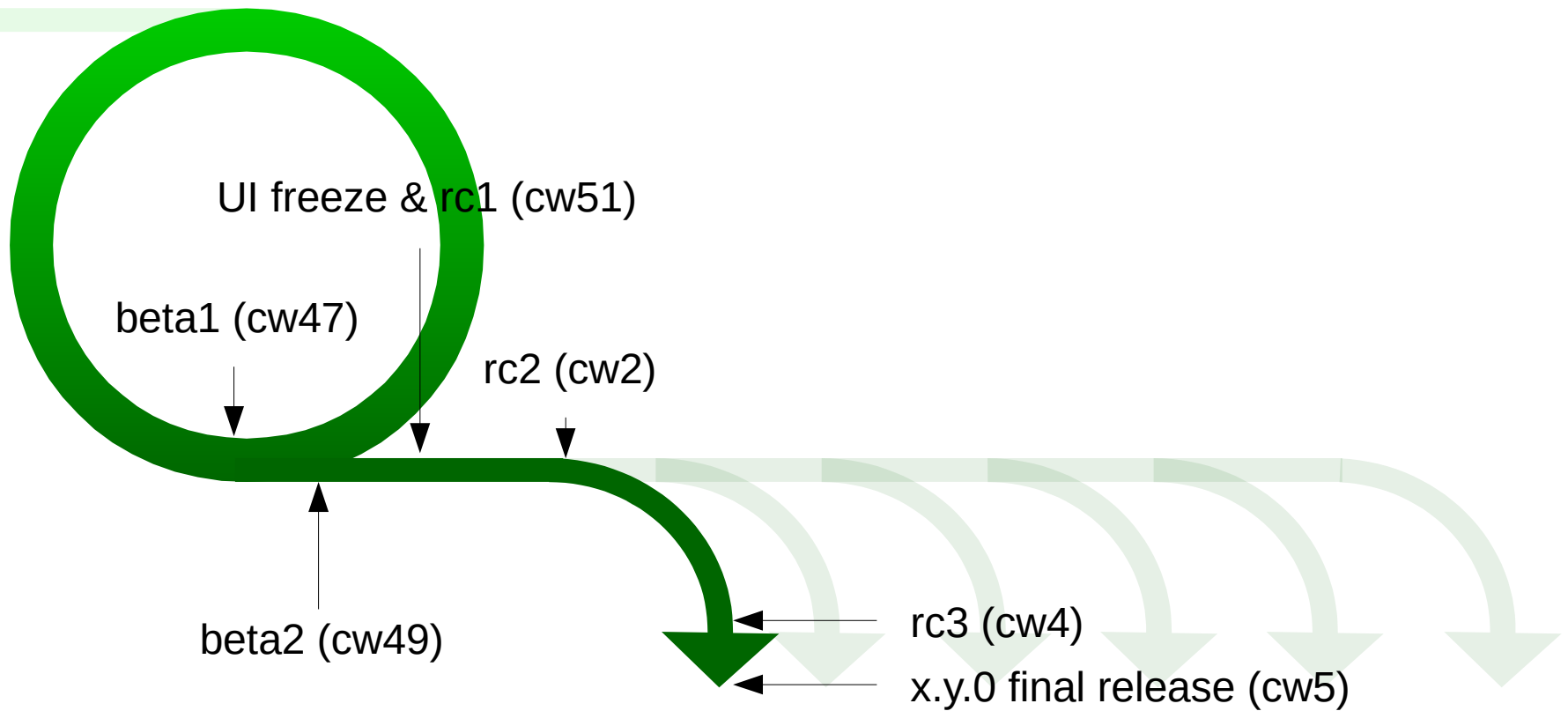


LibreOffice Release Branch (11 months)





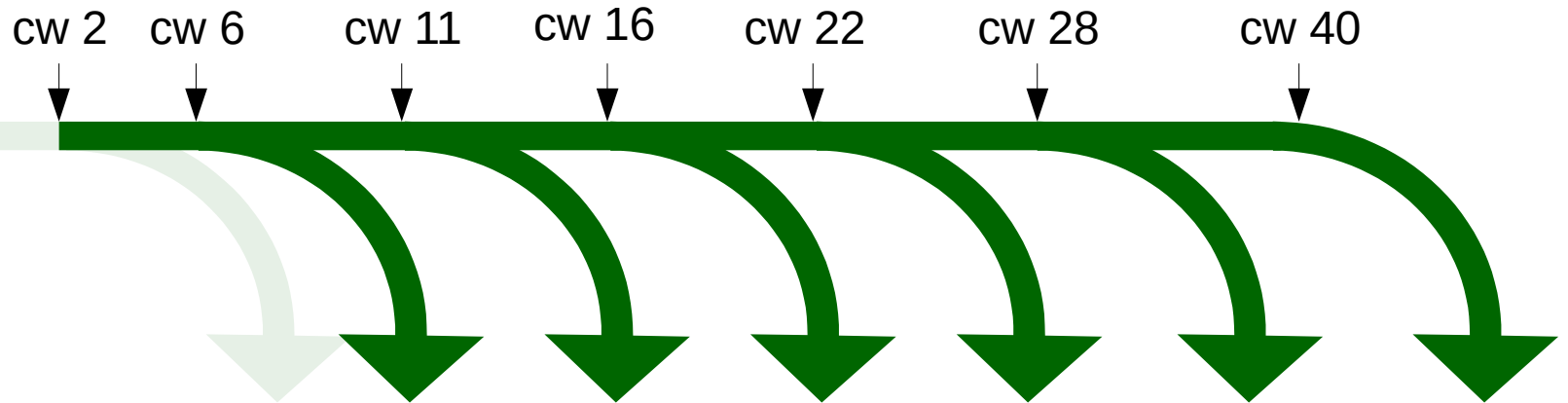
LibreOffice First Major Release (x.y.0)





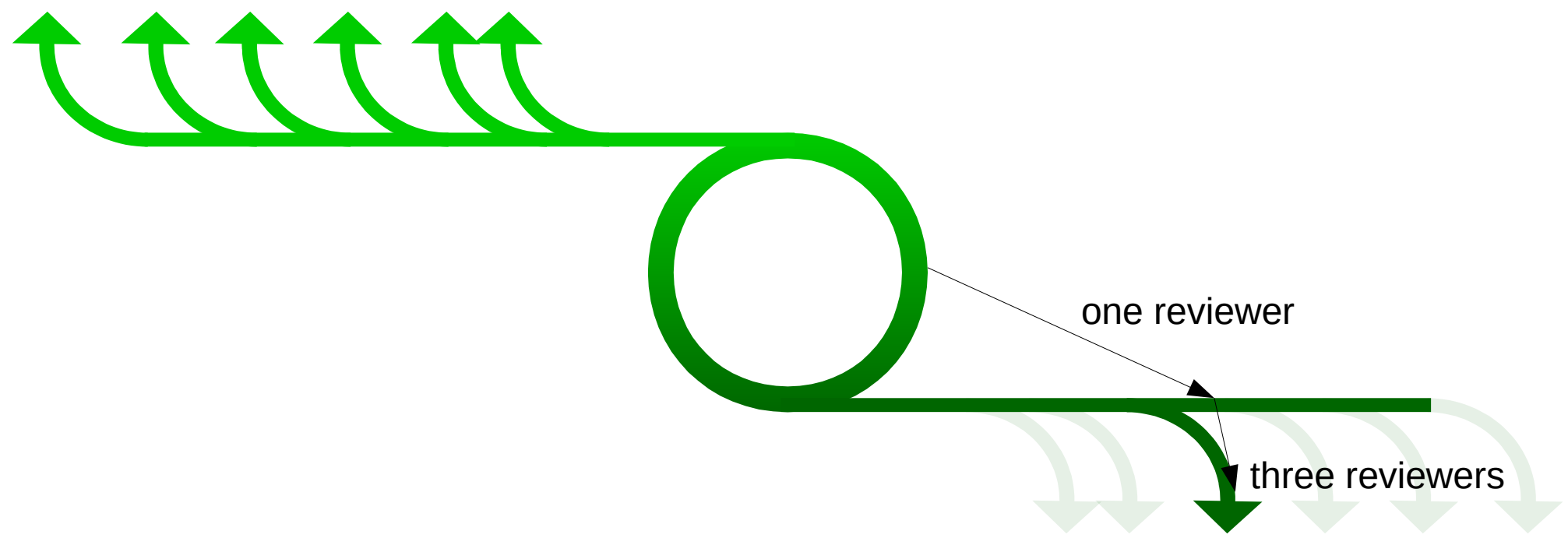
LibreOffice Bugfix Releases (x.y.1 – x.y.6)

- final release another week later



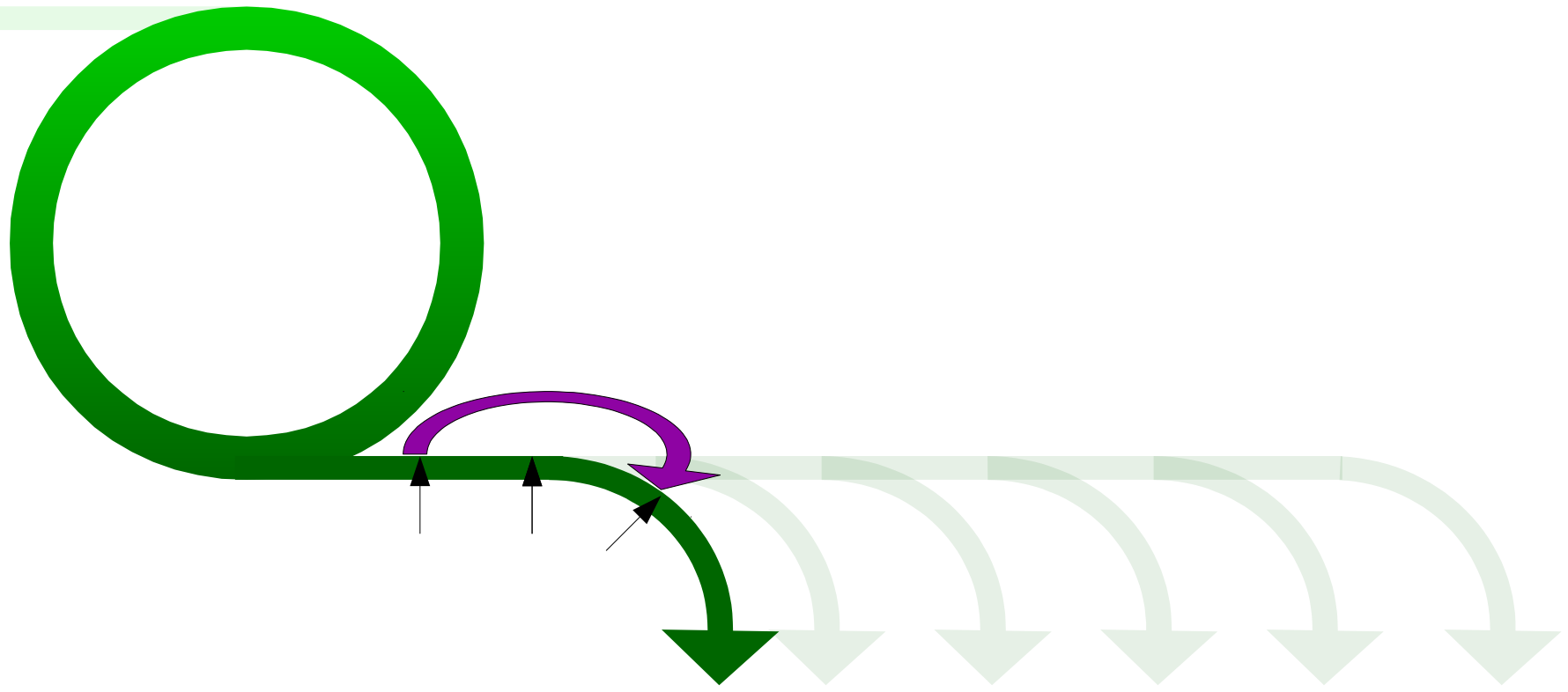

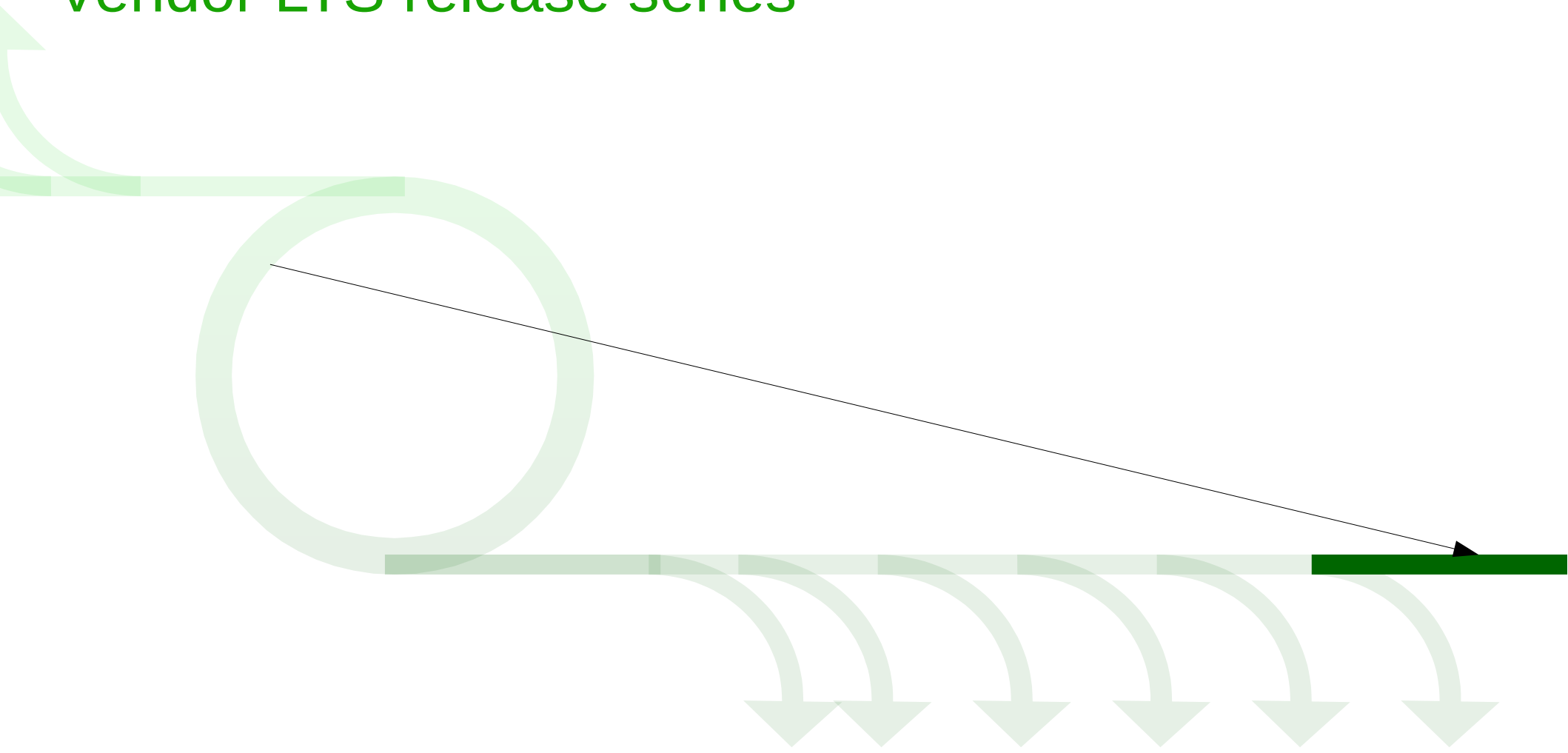

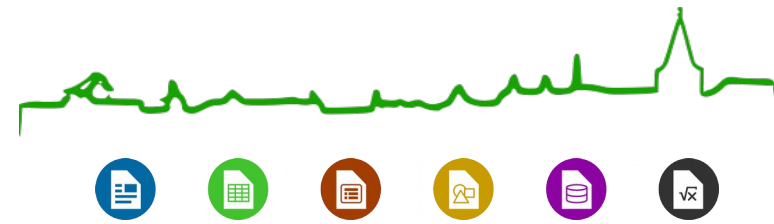
